

## Grades 7-12 Supply List 2021-2022

### General Supplies:

- Blue or black pens
- 1 pkg red pens
- #2 pencils or mechanical pencils
- Erasers
- Basic, non-graphing calculator
- Colored pencils
- Bible (ESV, If your child already has a Bible, it is not necessary to buy a new one. We recommend the ESV.)
- 8 packages (to start) of white 3 x 5 ruled index cards
- 3 highlighters
- 2 pkgs. graph paper (may need more for math)
- 2 packages of loose leaf wide ruled paper—**Restock as necessary**
- Ruler with inches and centimeters
- Book covers for all textbooks; purchased or homemade
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 protractor
- 1 compass
- Tracing paper
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 containers Clorox wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 can of Lysol spray
- Headphones
- Personal Hand Sanitizer (with clip for attaching to backpack)
- Personal Water Bottle
- Personal Face Mask

### Subject Specific:

- **Algebra 1 and Transition Math**— 3 ring binder (preferably more than 2 inches)
- **Algebra 2, Trig, Pre-Calculus, Chemistry**—Notebook or binder with paper, folder, a graphing calculator (Texas Instruments TI-83 plus or TI-84 plus) required. **Note:** More expensive calculators with programming capabilities are not allowed on State Testing, PSAT, ACT, AP tests, etc.
- **C101 and C121:** binder, loose-leaf paper, scientific calculator (will not be able to use a graphing calculator)
- **Calculus** – Graphing calculator, binder or notebook, folder, AP Calculus AB Exam Prep Book by Princeton Review
- **Biology** – 3-4 composition notebooks, colored pencils, glue sticks, scissors
- **Latin I and II-** one notebook for notes and one folder to keep old quizzes and tests
- **7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Math** – 2-2 ½ in. binders, 2-3 binder dividers, loose leaf or bound notebook dedicated for math
- **8<sup>th</sup> Science** – 2 or 2 ½ in binder, 6 binder dividers, scientific calculator (beyond TI-30Xa)
- **7<sup>th</sup> Life Science** – 3-4 Composition books, colored pencils, glue sticks, scissors
- **7-8<sup>th</sup> Writing** – (1) 3X5 cards (3 packs), (2) One 3x5 notecard container and (3) 1" black binder (preferably a Staples Better View Binder with D-rings)
- **9-12<sup>th</sup> Social Studies** –a folder or notebook for notes and handouts
- **9-12<sup>th</sup> Science**—a composition notebook, 1 binder, 1 scientific calculator (Not TI83-84CE)
- **AP Biology** – 3-4 Composition Books, colored pencils, glue sticks and scissors
- **AP Physics** – Graphing Calculator, 3 spiral notebooks, graphing paper, AP Physics 1 Exam Prep book by Princeton Review
- **Physics** – Notebook, folder, composition graphing notebook, graphing calculator
- **Life Science** – 3 ring binder (2" or Larger) and folder
- **9-12<sup>th</sup> English-** 1 pkg post-it notes and (1) 1.5" in. binder
- **Spanish** – 1 Spanish/English dictionary, 1 spiral notebook, and 1 folder
- **7-12<sup>th</sup> Bible** – Notebook paper, 1 binder for notes and handouts, Bible (ESV)
- **Photography** – DSLR or mirrorless camera (need to be able to adjust aperture, shutter speed, ISO, white balance, etc. in manual mode), lens for DSLR, SD Card (16GB min), Battery, Camera Bag, Pocket Size Notebook
